~Celebrating the Quarter-Century Milestone Anniversary~
We will welcome guests with various events to commemorate the 25th anniversary of the registration of "Shrines and Temples of Nikko" as World Heritage sites.



Nikko City is proud of its "Shrines and Temples of Nikko" as UNESCO World Heritage Site, and this Site boasts of its picturesque and famous buildings such as Nikko Toshogu Shrine, Nikko-zan Rinno-ji Temple, and Nikko Futarasan-Jinja Shrine, as well as the cultural landscape formed by the surrounding natural environment.

It was 1:05 am on December 2nd, 1999, when those concerned gathered under the winter sky received the exciting news from the 23rd World Heritage Committee that the "Shrines and Temples of Nikko" were to be inscribed on the World Heritage List. Those who knew the situation at that moment say that the excitement was so great that it blew away the cold.

During the quarter century since then, we have had many domestic and international guests, and on December 4th, 2024, we will celebrate the 25th anniversary of our registration. To make this commemorative year more exciting, we, Nikko City Tourism Association, established the Executive Committee for the 25th Anniversary of the World Heritage Registration in partnership with those who are related to the shrines and temples, and various groups and associations in Nikko area.

Also, the committee will hold a variety of commemorative events in cooperation with various event organizers in Nikko. We hope you will come to Nikko and enjoy many of the events we have planned for the 25th anniversary.

My Shogun Story Ogasawara-Ryu Experience

The Ogasawara-Ryu etiquette, which has been passing down the proper behavior of samurai for over eight centuries, consists of three styles: etiquette, archery, and horseback archery. In etiquette, people learn how to stand, walk, sit, eat, and so on, while also forming the mind of a martial artist and learning to eliminate unnecessary movements and refine them in daily actions.

In this special plan, you will receive a precise explanation from a specialist guide, visit a special place that is usually off-limits, morning prayer, and a specially arranged Nikko traditional vegetarian breakfast.

Those statues were made in Edo era, and those are said to bring good health and prosperity. Buddha "Five Great Kings" were worshipped by the founder of Nikko, Shodo Shonin,




